Crossing the Bar

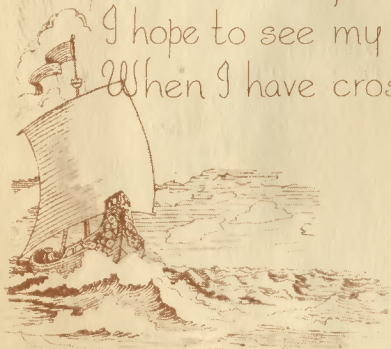
Sunset and evening star,
